Our project is operational at this time.

B. If project is operational, describe its overall progress to date by each task in the project.

From October 1st 2015, to March 2016, the Franklin County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) has expended approximately \$13,969.02 dollars in Occupant Protection funds. During that same time period the FCSO has generated the following statistics:

- Patrolled 374.25 hours,
- Stopped 305 vehicles for an average of .82 vehicles stopped an hour,
- Contacted 579 individuals,
- Issued 183 warnings,
- Issued 142 Vermont Civil Violation Complaints,
- VCVCs total value of \$23,549 dollars,

- Issued five VCVCs for safety belt violations,
- Issued five VCVCs for hand held devices,
- Made six arrests for non-DUI violations.


These numbers are also not based upon statistically our busiest time of the year, May-September. I can only expect a greater increase in the above numbers while patrolling in the warmer months of the year.

From January to March the DUI grant has produced the following results:

- 173.5 hours patrolled
- 120 vehicles stopped
- 281 persons contacted in vehicles
- 1 checkpoint – 34 vehicles, 85 persons contacted
- 47 VCVC's issued
- \$8,551.00 in VCVC fines
- 1 non-DUI arrest
- 4 DUI arrests
- 5 designated drivers encountered
- \$6,586.22 spent on salary for this period.

C. If there are any unanticipated delays, describe what caused the delay and steps being taken to correct conditions.

No delays, in fact we have submitted a request for additional funding.
