
- ► Fair and Impartial policing committee since 2009

2018 Review

- Publication of traffic stop data for Vermont State Police on Web Site - 6/18/19
 - https://vsp.vermont.gov/communityaffairs/trafficstops
 - Publication of raw data in an Excel easy to read format
 - Individual Trooper stops are analyzed.
- Quarterly Data Audits expanded
 - Cases reviewed that could have been generated by Discretionary MV Stops
- On Going Training LEO and Admin
- Addressing new issues as found.
- Continued support from Command Staff and Station Commanders for improving Data Quality.


