

GICSD 1ST QUARTER REPORT NH16402-118

High visibility enforcement efforts in conjunction with public education resulted in the following data for this quarter.

GICSD Crashes Investigated: 21

- Alburgh – 8 crashes
- South Hero – 6 crashes
- North Hero – 3 crashes
- Grand Isle – 2 crashes
- Isle LaMotte – 1 crash
- Detail (Highgate) – 1 crash

Three (3) reported crash involving personal injury:

- ❖ Isle LaMotte – 10/14/2015 1554 hours – motorcycle vs. turkey – operator and a witness stated turkey flew into his face causing him to crash. Precautionary medical transport due to possible head injury with facial lacerations.
- ❖ South Hero – 10/30/2015 1558 hours – single vehicle rollover with entrapment – witnesses stated the operator was driving erratically crossing the centerline and fog line before crossing into the oncoming lane, going airborne and rolling twice end over end. Safety restraints were used. Medical transport to hospital. Suspected medical incident prior to crash.
- ❖ Grand Isle – 11/23/2015 0836 hours – vehicle vs. vehicle – operator 1 failed to yield the right of way to operator 2. Safety restraints were used. Precautionary medical transport due to minor injuries.
